Greetings, members and friends of St. Andrew's! It gives me great joy that I will be serving as your Interim Pastor in this sacred time of pastoral transition. My time with you begins on December 1 and my

first Sunday leading worship with you will be December 4.

I am proud to call Oshkosh my hometown. In fact, I grew up less than a mile from St. Andrew's and have many fond memories of your congregation over the years. After graduating from Oshkosh North (go Spartans!), I received my undergraduate degree from UW-La Crosse and my M.Div. degree from The Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago.
