Dear members and friends of St. Andrew's,

Welcome to 2023! I am grateful for all your kindness and support in my first month with you as Interim Pastor, and I trust that our partnership in the coming months will only grow stronger as I help you navigate this time of pastoral transition.

With the busyness of the Advent and Christmas season behind us, I am sure several of you are eager to know a little more about what comes next in the transition process as you prepare to call your next settled pastor. This month, I share an excerpt of the covenant agreed upon by the leadership of St. Andrew's, the Office of Bishop of the East-Central Synod of Wisconsin, and myself as your Interim Pastor. As someone who has always valued the importance of clear communication and goals, I share this with you in hopes that what is outlined below may serve as a helpful reminder for the good and faithful work that we are each called upon to carry out in Jesus' name.

### <u>Members and Friends of St. Andrew's Lutheran</u> <u>Church:</u>

- A. Commit to the Gospel by faithful participation in worship, learning, and fellowship activities.
- B. Support the ministry of the congregation through your service and gifts.
- C. Accept Pastor Bryan as your Interim Pastor, uphold him in prayer, and accord him love, respect, and good will.

- D. Expect Pastor Bryan to preside at baptisms, celebrations of Holy Communion, and other rites of the church.
- E. Agree that Pastor Bryan will not be considered for regular call to this congregation.

## <u>Pastor Bryan as Interim Pastor of St. Andrew's</u> <u>Lutheran Church</u>:

- A. See to the core attributes of pastoral ministry to the congregation: preach and teach the Word of God; preside at worship; provide pastoral care; officiate weddings, funerals, etc., and give pastoral leadership for the meetings and activities of the congregation.
- B. Devote time and energy to assessing current youth ministry at St. Andrew's, and providing care, attention, and support to the congregation to make future youth programming more sustainable.
- C. Encourage support of the total ministry of the ELCA and the East Central Synod of Wisconsin and provide a monthly report to the Office of Bishop.
- D. Be responsible for the recording of baptisms, confirmations, marriages, funerals, etc.
- E. Agree under no circumstances to: be available for regular call to this congregation, be involved in the congregation's call process except when the synod bishop requests such participation and, become a member of this congregation after his time as Interim Pastor of St. Andrew's concludes.

Next month, I'll talk more about the work we are called upon to share together, the support of our East-Central Synod of Wisconsin, and a general outline of what the call process will look like. In the meantime, **THANK YOU** for your faithful partnership! You are a blessing to this congregation and all of its good and faithful work.
