We enter this month during Holy Week with a wide range of actions and emotions. We experience God-moving and life-changing events in our faith lives:

April 2nd (6:30 p.m. worship) Maundy Thursday – Jesus transforms the Passover meal from a work of remembrance to the Lord's Supper, in which Jesus now share's his life and love, to forgive us. The meal is accessible to us at all times. Jesus is present every meal. And we receive forgiveness, mercy, and grace every time.

April 3rd (6:30 p.m. worship) Good Friday – We observe the passion of Jesus Christ, acknowledging Jesus' sacrificial love for us and for the world. He gives His life for us.

April 5th (7 & 9:30 a.m. worship) Easter Sunday! – We have the opportunity to worship and praise God for Jesus' life, death and New Life. This day and season signify that Jesus' Resurrection is real and changes our lives. Jesus' work on the cross guarantees the promise of the resurrection for all of us. We live our lives to reflect our thankfulness for God's love for us. (You have the opportunity to celebrate with your church family by partaking in Easter Breakfast at St. Andrew's on Easter Sunday morning also! 😊)

You are invited into the whole story of God's saving love for you, this holy week and throughout the Easter Season.
